## ***Prof. Benedykt Błoński / Poland, chairman of the jury***

Benedykt Błoński was born in 1957. He is a graduate of the Fryderyk Chopin Academy of Music in Warsaw. He has worked with the Prof. W. Wawrzyczek Choir, currently, he is working with the choir of the University of Warmia and Mazury. With this choir he has participated in Polish and international competitions and festivals, winning a series of the highest prizes (gold medals, as well as Grand Prix). Since 2009, he has led the Choir CANTORES VARMIENSES for Warmia and Mazury Philharmonic. For his

artistic and teaching activities he has been honoured with numerous prestigious Awards such as the Gold Cross of Merit, individual awards of the 1st degree of the Rector of the University of Warmia and Mazury in Olsztyn, and many others. His achievements include recording of 13 CDs. Benedykt Błoński has also conducted hundreds of concerts in Poland and abroad (e.g Greece, Ireland, United Kingdom, Belgium, France, the Vatican, Italy, Spain, Germany, Russia, Mexico, Argentina), performing Polish and foreign music, including premiere performances. He has held positions in artistic councils and juries of numerous choral competitions and festivals, both domestic and international. Benedykt Błoński has been an artistic director of international choral workshops "Eurochor 2001", the artistic director of the Polish - German Choral Academy "In terra pax", the artistic director of the F. Nowowiejski International Choir Festival. He is a member of the International Choir Olympic Council. He lectures at the Academy of Music in Bydgoszcz and the National Centre for Culture in Warsaw. Professor Błoński currently holds a position of the Dean in the Faculty of Arts of the University of Warmia and Mazury. In 1999 he was awarded the academic title of Professor of Musical Arts by the President of the Republic of Poland.



## ***Doc. Ondrej Šaray. ArtD. / Slovakia***

Ondrej Šaray studied orchestral conducting with Zdeněk Bílek at the Conservatory in Bratislava. He also studied with Ladislav Slovák at the Academy of Music and Dramatic Arts in Bratislava. Since 1983 he has worked as the conductor of the Bratislava Children's Choir. In 1987 he established the Youth Choir Echo and in 1992 the Amadeus Choir Bratislava. Ondrej Šaray has won many significant domestic and international awards with these choirs. As a conductor, he has performed throughout Europe,

Canada, Africa, the USA and he also cooperated with the noted orchestras of Slovakia (Philharmonic Orchestra, State Philharmonic Orchestra Košice, State Chamber Orchestra Žilina). He and his choirs appear regularly in vocal-instrumental compositions with the Slovak Philharmonic Orchestra, Slovak Chamber Orchestra of Bohdan Warchal, Capella

Istropolitana and Musica Aeterna. Ondrej Šaray has also made recordings for Slovak Radio, Slovak Television and BBC London. Besides conducting, he teaches at the Academy of Music and Dramatic Arts in Bratislava.

***Prof. Margrethe Ek / Norway***

Margrethe Ek from Norway, started conducting at the age of 14. Ek studied music for eight years, including master in singing, an education in music performance and presentation, and a diploma in conducting from the Norwegian Academy of Music. She has written a book of the health benefits of singing in a choir (Cantando 2012). An article of choir and health benefits have been published in the bulletin of international federation of choral music (IFCM april 2014). Ek currently works as a professor in Kirkeparken high school. She has previously worked at the University of Oslo within the subjects of song and conduction for 11 years. Being a conductor filled with energy and dynamic presentations, she has conducted several ensembles at high levels within several genres – both choirs and instrumental ensembles (symphony orchestras and wind ensembles). Ek's different ensembles have often been seen on national TV and radio, and they have participated in choir contests at international levels with great results. Margrethe Ek has been acknowledged as both a lecturer and a visiting conductor for both businesses and musical ensembles in Norway. She is often invited to be a judge in both national and international choir contests. Today Margrethe Ek is the conductor of Moss Ensemble Consensus, founded in 2010:

***Prof. Luc Anthonis / Belgium***

Luc Anthonis started his musical career at the music academy of his hometown Ekeren. He developed a particular fascination for choral music while singing in the youth choir Carmina under the direction of Jozef Cleymans. At the Royal Flemish Music Conservatory of Antwerp Luc Anthonis received qualifications for flute, chamber music, harmony and choral conducting. He rounded out his knowledge on choral music and choral conducting in master classes with Jan Eelkema, Michael Scheck, Eric Ericson, Simon Halsey, Péter Erdei and others. In 1980 Luc Anthonis took over the youth choir Cantilene from its founder Jozef Cleymans and in 1989 he himself founded Cantando, choirs that still under his direction. The latter has won a great number of prizes in national and international competitions. He also conducted the Flemish Radio Choir on a regular basis. Luc Anthonis is a standard member of the jury for choir contests in Belgium and abroad. In 2007 he became professor of choral conducting at the Royal Flemish Music Conservatory in Antwerp.

### ***Prof. Dariusz Dyczewski / Poland***

On Nov. 30th 2013 was appointed methodology advisor by the Minister of Culture and National Heritage for Poland for the years 2014/2017. In 2013 was chosen to be the President of the Polish Choir Society and Orchestras in Poland for 2013/2017. On Nov. 3rd 2011 was awarded the title professor of music of art by the President of Poland. Since 2010 has been consultant of the Centre of Artistic Education in Warsaw. In the year 2006 was assigned the position of the artistic director of the International Festival of Choir Songs in Międzyzdroje.

Has been the Head of private both Primary and Secondary Music Schools, founded by Leonard Piwoni in Szczecin. Since 2003 has been the chairman of the Polish Association of Choir and Orchestra in Szczecin.



### ***Mag. Jürgen Partaj / Austria***

Jürgen Partaj was born in Vienna into a family of music enthusiasts and so came into early contact with the Austrian choral scene. He studied violin with Eva Bru and attended master classes with Christian Altenburger and Ernst Kovacic. Initially he was active purely in the field of classical music in solo, chamber music and orchestral projects but his concert activity gradually shifted towards crossover. His musical career is complemented by performances with Oscar winner Glen Hansard, concerts as a guest musician in various international performing groups, several CD productions, broadcasts on international TV and radio stations as well as the musical direction at festivals and theatre productions, among others in the framework of the Wiener Festwochen. Besides his musical activities Jürgen Partaj graduated in law with a focus on arts law and founded a music agency in 2000 that specialized in international orchestral and choral tour management. Jürgen Partaj had the opportunity to work with outstanding musicians such as Elina Garanca, Annette Dasch, Julian Rachlin, Joe Zawinul, Rebekka Bakken, Al Jarreau, Randy Newman, Lalo Schifrin and with choral conductors such as Erwin Ortner, Robert Page and Simon Carrington. Jürgen Partaj was founder and director of the contemporary music festival at Schloss Ebelsberg before he founded the „Summa Cum Laude International Youth Music Festival“ in 2007 together with the Association Via Musica – a festival for youth choirs and youth orchestras from all over the world. As intendant and artistic director, he annually creates over 100 music events in the Czech Republic, Slovakia, Hungary and Austria.

## *art director of the festival*

### ***Dr. Milan Kolena / Slovakia - art director of the festival***

At the Zilina Conservatory he studied piano, singing and choir conducting. After graduating with a degree in Choral Conducting at the University of Performing Arts (VSMU) in Bratislava under the tutelage of Prof. Peter Hradil, he continued his studies in sacred music at VSMU. He also continued his studies of Gregorian Chant with Prof. J.Kohlhauf at the University for Music and Darstellende Kunst in Vienna where he is the author of the first Slovak professional publication on Gregorian chant: "Súčasné smery v interpretácii gregorianskeho chorálu" (Current Directions in Interpretation of Gregorian Chant). He actively cooperates in the interpretation of Gregorian chant with Prof. Dr. F.K. Prassl from Graz and Prof. Dr. J.B. Goschl from Munich. Milan Kolena was an assistant with the Chlapčenský zbor (Boys' choir) in Bratislava and was conductor of the Spevácky zbor bratislavských učitelia (Bratislava Teachers' Choir). In addition, he currently serves as conductor of Schola Gregoriana Bratislavensis. Milan Kolena teaches choir conducting and Gregorian chant at VŠMU. Since 1998 Milan Kolena has been the Art Director of the International Sacred Music Choir Festival Námestovské hudobné slavnosti, Musica Sacra in Bratislava, Slovakia Cantat. He is active as a Jury member at national and international choral competitions in Czech Republic, Poland, Italy, Slovakia. He has led many workshops and seminars about vocal polyphony, Gregorian chant and Slovak contemporary music. During 2004-2006 together with Schola Gregoriana Bratislavensis recorded 3 CDs of Bratislava antiphons for Slovak National Library. Since 2013 he is the president of the Slovak Choral Association.



In 2014 he gave lectures at three American universities: Illinois Wesleyan University School, University of Missouri School of Music, Colorado State University, topic: The Question of the Interpretation of Latin texts in Sacred Choral Music.

He was awarded the best conductor special prize of the „Singing World“ choral competition in St. Petersburg, Russia in 2015. In the same year he also did workshops in China and Hong Kong.

Detský spevácky zbor ZŠ F.Bevka z mestečka Tolmin oslavuje tento rok 10. výročie svojho založenia. Spieva v ňom okolo 50 detí, ktoré zbožňujú spievanie v tomto zbere, pretože napriek náročnej práci sú nácviky vždy radostné. Ich námaha je odmenená mnohými zlatými medailami z rôznych festivalov.



Children's Choir of the Elementary School has the 10th anniversary this year. About 50 children sing in this choir who love singing in the choir because rehearsals are always joyful, even thought they are working hard. Their hard work is always rewarded and the gold medals from many different competitions confirm this.

Barbara Kovačič vyštudovala organ na Škole pre organistov a ukončila vysokoškolské štúdium na Pedagogickej fakulte v Ljubljane. Aktívne sa zúčastňuje majstrovských kurzov a seminárov pod vedením známych odborníkov na vokálne umenie a neustále si prehľbuje vzdelanie v oblasti zborového dirigovania. Často organizuje hudobné dielne s mnohými dirigentmi, instrumentalistami a inými odborníkmi – umelcami. V súčasnosti pracuje na Základnej Škole Franceta Bevka Tolmin, kde vedie 4 detské a jeden mládežnícky zbor v ktorých spieva viac než 140 detí. Vysoko systematická práca prináša výsledky v podobe mnohých ocenení na národných i medzinárodných festivaloch, ako aj mnoho koncertov, či iných projektov. Okrem práce v škole vedie už 30 rokov Dievčenský zbor Pueri Cantores. Skrze svoju prácu podporuje tvorbu nových skladieb a premiéry vokálnych diel svetského i sakrálnego charakteru. Spolupracuje s významnými skladateľmi, dirigentmi, spevákmi, inštrumentalistami a orchestrami.

Mrs. Barbara Kovačič studied organ at School for Organists and graduated at the Faculty of Education in Ljubljana. She takes active part in master classes and seminars with recognized specialists of vocal music and constantly deepens her knowledge in the conducting field. She frequently organizes musical workshops with numerous conductors, instrumentalists and other musical specialists. She is currently employed at the Primary school Franceta Bevka Tolmin, where she is leading 4 children choirs and a youth choir with more than 140 singers. Highly systematic work reflects in several prizes from national and international competitions as well as numerous concerts and different projects. Besides her school choirs Mrs. Barbara Kovačič has been leading a Girls choir Pueri Cantores for 30 years now. Through her work with the choirs Barbara encourages composing and enables first performances of vocal works, both profane and sacred character. She cooperates with established composers, conductors, vocalists, instrumentalists and orchestras.

Detský spevácky zbor Hudobnej školy Velenje vznikol pred viac než 30 rokmi. Od roku 1987 vedie zbor pani Manja Gošnik Vovk. Keďže väčšina zboristov sú klaviristi a gitaristi, zborový spev je jednou z mála príležitostí k skupinovej hudobnej aktivite. Detský spevácky zbor Hudobnej školy Velenje je jedným z najúspešnejších detských zborov v krajinе prakticky už od začiatku. Od roku 1994 získali 10 zlatých pásiem (posledné v roku 2016) a šestkrát bol vyhlásený za najlepší slovinský zbor na národnej súťaži detských a mládežníckych zborov v Zagorje. Na medzinárodných súťažiach získali 4 zlaté pásma. Výsledkom ich tvrdéj práce je aj niekoľko CD: »Šťastné dieťa«, »Maľovaná kačka«, »S hrou do čaroveného sveta hudby«.

Manja Gošnik Vovk ukončila štúdium klavíra a hudobnej výchovy na Hudobnej Akadémii v Ljubljane. Od roku 1978 pracuje na Hudobnej škole F.K. Velenje, kde učí klavír a diriguje detský zbor. Je aktívnu speváckou a umeleckou asistentkou Speváckej školy Carmina Slovenica a Mládežníckeho zboru Carmina Slovenica. V roku 2008 jej starosta Velenje udeli ocenenie za jej úspešnú pedagogickú a umeleckú prácu a za jej prínos mestu Velenje. V roku 2014 jej Asociácia slovinských hudobných škôl udeliла Cenu Fran Gerbiča za jej výnimočný úspech v oblasti hudobného vzdelávania a interpretácie.



Children's choir of Velenje music school was founded more than 30 years ago. Since 1987 its conductor is Manja Gošnik Vovk. The choir consists



of children aged 6 to 11 years, most of them are pupils of Velenje Music School. Since they are mostly pianists and guitarists, the choir singing is one of the rare opportunities to experience making music in a group. Children's choir of Velenje music school is one of the top national choirs in their category practically since its beginnings. Since 1994 the choir won ten golden awards (last one in 2016) and was six

times proclaimed as the best children's choir at the Slovene national children's and youth choirs competition in Zagorje. On international level choir won four golden awards. As a result of a long and hard work the choir released CDs: »Veseli otrok« ('Happy child'), Pisana račka (»Painted duck«), »Z igro v čarobni svet glasbe« (»With the game to the magical world of music«).

Manja Gošnik Vovk graduated from the Music Academy in Ljubljana, piano and music education. Since 1978 she has worked at the Music School Fran Korun Koželjski Velenje, where she has been teaching the piano and conducting the children's choir. She is an active singer and rehearsal coach of the Academic Choir of Velenje until the season 2015/2016; she conducts the choir of the Carmina Slovenica Singing School and the Junior Choir Carmina Slovenica. In 2008 she was bestowed recognition from the Mayor of the Municipality of Velenje for her successful educational and artistic work as well as her contribution to the recognition of the Municipality of Velenje. In 2014 the Association of Slovene Music Schools awarded her with the Fran Gerbič recognition for her remarkable success in the field of music education and music interpretation.

Pravidelne spievajú a zúčastňujú sa na miestnych, národných aj medzinárodných zborových súťažiach. Nahrali vlastné CD a predstavili muzikál Čarodejník z krajin Oz. Už niekoľko rokov sa zbor zúčastňuje na významnom podujatí v Olomouci, kde v roku 2011 získali strieborné pásmo. V roku 2013 bol zbor vybraný na regionálnu súťaž a získal striebornú medailu. She has been leading Male-voice's choir Paloma Sladki Vrh for 5 years, Folk's choir singers in Volicina (6 years), helped the autochthonous folk music Girls' vocal group Sladki Vrh, Female's choir Primary School Sladki Vrh. She wrote music for a puppet show and arranged songs for choirs and school's band. She prepared, arranged and directed the musical The Wizard of Oz.

Každý rok pripravujeme spolu s detským zborom vianočný a novoročný koncert a každoročný koncert v máji. Zúčastňujeme sa na každom školskom podujatí a iných mestských akciách. Zároveň sme pravidelné súčasťou regionálnych zborových prehliadok, kde sme vždy získali vysoké hodnotenia. 

Dievčenský spevácky zbor je jedným z najaktívnejších uměleckých zoskupení na Strednej hudobnej škole a snaží sa dosahovať najvyššie hudobné a umělecké ciele. Repertoár dievčenského speváckeho zboru je veľmi široký a obsahuje aranžmány lotyšských ľudových piesní, sakrálne i svetské klasické, romantické i moderné skladby. Posledné dva roky pracuje zbor pod vedením Andrixa Kontautsa, ktorý sa vysokou mierou príčinil o jeho profesionálny rozvoj. V tomto roku zbor navštieva 40 dievčat vo veku 12 – 18 rokov. Každé popoludnie chodia dievčatá do hudobnej školy na hodiny spevu, história hudby a klavíra. Zbor vystupoval v mnohých koncertných sieňach a kostoloch v Lotyšsku aj v zahraničí. Spolupracoval so Symfonickým orchestrom Liepaja.

Andris Kontauts sa narodil v roku 1974 v meste Liepaja v Lotyšsku. Získal všeestranné vzdelanie – má kvalifikáciu psychologického poradcu pre základné školy, magisterský titul z pedagogiky a vzdelávania a tiež magisterský titul zo zborového dirigovania na Hudobnej akadémii Jazepsa Vitolса. Od roku 1998 pracuje na Strednej hudobnej škole Emīlis Melngailis. V súčasnosti učí mládežnícky zbor a vede školský dievčenský zbor a zmiešaný zbor „Mare“. Napísal niekoľko zbierok skladieb pre detské, ženské a zmiešané zbyry a získal ocenenie odbornej poroty na Lotyšskej súťaži zborovej piesne (1. miesto). Niekoľko jeho skladieb sa stalo súčasťou repertoáru na Lotyšskom Festivale Piesní a na Študentskom festivale „Gaudeamus“.



The Girl's Choir is one of the best and the most active musical groups in the Secondary School of Music, which seeks to achieve the highest musical and artistic goals. The repertoire of the Girl's Choir is very wide, including arrangements of Latvian folk songs as well as original songs, sacral and secular ancient classical, romantic and modern music. For the last ten years Andris Kontauts has been the Choir's conductor contributing much effort in its Professional development. This year forty girls aged 12-18 are singing in the Choir. Every day after school, the girls go to Music School and learn solfeggio, music history and to play the piano. The choir has performed in various concert halls and churches both in Latvia and abroad. It has also performed together with Liepaja Symphony Orchestra.

Andris Kontauts was born in 1974 in Liepaja, Latvia. He has acquired a very comprehensive education – a qualification as a primary school consulting psychologist, a Master's Degree in the history of didactics and pedagogy, as well as a Master's Degree in choir conducting specialty at Jazeps Virts Latvia Academy of Music. Since 1998 Andris Kontauts has been working as a teacher at Emīlis Melngailis Liepaja Secondary School of Music; currently he teaches young choir and conducts both the school girl's choir and mixed voice choir „Mare“. He has greatly increased the repertoire of children, women and mixed choirs with several song collections and has gained Professional recognition of the jury in the Latvian Choral Song Competition (1 st prize). Several songs have been included and performed in Latvian Song Festival and Student Song Festival „Gaudeamus“.

Zmiešaný zbor Európskeho hlavného mesta kultúry je spevácke zoskupenie, ktoré spája spevákov s rôznymi speváckymi skúsenosťami. Zbor spieva estónsku a severskú hudbu, klasické aj moderné skladby inovatívnym spôsobom. Zbor sa zúčastnil a získal ocenenia na festivaloch v Číne, Vietnamu, Indonézii, Rakúsku, Lotyšsku a Malte. Rozvíja sa dynamicky a sústredí sa najmä na propagáciu estónskej zborovej tradície. Má svoje tradície ako sú vianočné koncerty, či intenzívne zborové sústredenia dvakrát do roka, aby sa pripravili na medzinárodné súťaže, či dôležité koncerty.

Dirigent Rihards Zarinš vyštudoval na Lotyšskej Hudobnej Akadémii Jazepsa Vitolsa u Marisa Sirmaisa v roku 2014. Pracoval ako zbormajster pre mládežnícky zbor "Balsis" (dirigent Ints Teterovskis), ako pomocný dirigent v zmiešanom zbere "Sparnos" v Jurmale a viedol stredoškolský zmiešaný zbor. Pracuje tiež ako koordinátor zborov na Festivale piesne v Mežaparkse v Rige. Od roku 2014 študuje na Estónskej hudobnej a divadelnej akadémii u Toomasa Kaptena a pracuje ako profesionálny spevák v Národnom estónskom mužskom zbere.



The Mixed Choir of the European Capital of Culture is a choral group uniting singers with diverse backgrounds in musical performing. The choir performs Estonian and Nordic music, ranging from beloved classics to modern compositions with innovative sound and form. The choir is led by conductor Veronika Portsmith, PhD. The choir was formed in 2008. It was initiated by creative people involved in preparations for European

Capital of Culture events in Tallinn, 2011. The choir has participated and received nominations at choral singing contests and festivals in China, Vietnam, Indonesia, Austria, Latvia and Malta. The choir is in a dynamic development phase, its main focus is on performing varied forms of choral music and regular presentations of Estonian choral singing traditions globally. The choir has its traditions, including Christmas season concerts and intensive rehearsal weekends twice a year to prepare for international contests or exciting festivals.

Zmiešaný zbor katedry zborového dirigovania, cirkevnej hudby, umenieckej výchovy, rytmiky a jazzu na Hudobnej akadémii v Gdansku vznikol v októbri 2016. Komorný ženský zbor Bubureza sa na koncertných pódiach objavuje od roku 2008 a je jedným z najväčšieťnejších telies, v ktorého repertoári nájdeme gregoriánsky chorál i súčasnú hudbu. Zbor pod vedením Miloslavy Vítkovej sa obzvlášť zaoberať dielami 20. a 21. storočia, sčasti vďaka dirigentskému a autorskému vplyvu skladateľa Jana Rybára, ktorý s Buburezou pravidelne spolupracuje od roku 2013. Gloria Brunensis je ženský komorný zbor, ktorý vznikol v januári roku 2014 z iniciatívy jeho súčasnej dirigentky Natalie Chirilenco. Gloria Brunensis má vo svojom repertoári široké spektrum skladieb prelinajúcich sa naprieč obdobiami a hudobnými žánrami, od polyfónií až po súčasných autorov. Špecializuje sa najmä na a cappella skladba. Hoci je mladým zborom, má za sebou už niekoľko koncertov a niekoľko úspechov z domácich a zahraničných zborových súťaží. Patria medzi ne zlaté pásma v dvoch kategóriách z medzinárodného festivalu Festa Musicale v Olomouci v roku 2014, či cena za najlepšiu folklórnu pieseň a najlepšiu romantickú pieseň 19. storočia zo súťažnej prehliadky Medzinárodného zborového festivalu hudobného romantizmu vo Vlachove Březí v roku 2016.

Natalia Chirilenco sa narodila v Moldavsku kde do svojich 23 rokov navštěvovala hudobné lýceum. Absolvovala Akadémii hudobných umení v Kišiňove, odbor zborové dirigovanie. Od roku 1999 žije v České republice, kde za krátke časy získala Osvedčenie o uznaní kvalifikácie a rovnocennosti vysokoškolského vzdelania na Janáčkovej akadémii muzických umení. Počas svojej kariéry viedla a dirigovala niekoľko zborov, okrem iného zbor Konzervatória v Brne. Okrem dirigovania sa občas venuje i porotovaniu či lektoriu. Od roku 2014 diriguje a vede ženský spevácky zbor Gloria Brunensis, ktorý založila spolu



s bývalými členkami detského zboru Primavera.



Gloria Brunensis is a female chamber choir established in January 2014 by its current conductor Natalia Chirilenco. In its repertoire, the choir has a wide spectrum of compositions which encompass many periods and genres, ranging from polyphony to contemporary authors. The a cappella compositions are the Gloria Brunensis' specialty. Although the choir is young, it has already participated in numerous concerts and has had significant achievements in local and foreign competitions, for example the golden award in two categories at the international festival Festa Musicale in Olomouc in 2014 or the award for the best performance of a folk song and a romantic composition from the 19th century at the International choral festival of music from the Romantic period in Vlachovo Březí in 2016.

Natalia Chirilenco was born in Moldova, where she attended a music lyceum until the age of 23. She graduated from the Academy of Music in Chisinau, with specialization in choral conducting. She has been living in the Czech Republic since 1999, where she has received a Certificate of University Education Equivalence and Qualification Recognition at the Janáček Academy of the Performing Arts. She has been leading and conducting various choirs, including the choir of the Brno Conservatory of Music. Besides conducting she also takes up positions in juries and organizes private lectures. Since 2014 Natalia is the choirmaster of the female choir Gloria Brunensis, which she founded with some of the graduates of the Primavera children's chorus.

Založenie Komorného speváckeho zboru Mysterium ako súčasť Kultúrnej asociácie Mysterium Kranj v roku 2005 malo za cieľ obnoviť zborovú hudbu. Od jeho založenia zbor viedla pani Urška Štampe. Od septembra 2016 je umeleckým vedúcim zboru pán Gregor Klančič. Repertoár zboru zahŕňa svetskú aj sakrálnu hudbu slovinských aj zahraničných skladateľov. Zboristi sa radi zúčastňujú charitatívnych koncertov, festivalov a vytvárajú kontakty s inými zbormi. Zúčastňujú sa na rôznych festivaloch v Slovinsku aj v zahraničí, kde získali mnohé ocenenia.

Gregor Klančič je zborový dirigent a organista, ktorý vyštudoval cirkevnú hudbu na Hudobnej Akadémii v Lúblane. Spolupracuje so Slovinskou filharmóniou, speváckimi sólistami, inštrumentalistami a prominentnými slovinskými zbormi. Bol členom profesionálneho Slovinského komorného zboru a je jeho pomocným dirigentom od roku 2004. Je umeleckým vedúcim zboru Consortium Musicum a Komorného zboru Mysterium. Je hudobným manažérom lúblanskej arcidiecézy, riaditeľom a profesorom na organovej škole v Lúblane. Pracuje tiež ako organista v katedrále sv. Mikuláša v Lúblane.



The founding of The Mysterium Chamber Choir, a part of the Mysterium Kranj Culture Association, in autumn 2005 was driven by a desire to recreate choral. Since its inception, the post of the choir's artistic director was held by its co-founder and conductor, Mrs Urška Štampe. From September 2016 is the artistic director of the choir Mr Gregor Klančič. The repertoire comprises of both secular and sacred music, written by Slovene and foreign composers alike. In addition to regular concert activities, the choristers are happy to partake in charity concerts, appear at festivals and establish contacts with choirs from Slovenia and abroad. Both in Slovenia and abroad, the Choir regularly enters various competitions, often winning grand prizes.

Gregor Klančič, choir conductor and organist, who holds a degree in music pedagogy and church music, is a graduate of the Academy of Music, Ljubljana, Slovenia. He cooperates with the Slovenian Philharmonic Orchestra, also with many vocal soloists, instrumentalists and prominent Slovenian choirs. He was a member of a professional Slovenian Chamber Choir and is its assistant conductor since 2004. He is the artistic director of Consortium Musicum choir and The Mysterium Chamber Choir. Spevácky zbor Adijamus vznikol pred šiestimi rokmi pri Základnej umeleckej škole Viléma Petřelky v Ostrave-Hrabůvce. Aj keď sa Adijamus v zborovom svete pohybuje len krátka, má za sebou už niekoľko speváckych súťaží. Za svoj úspech považuje zisk Zlatého a Strieborného pásmu na Krajskej prehliadke DPS v Orlovej. V decembri 2015 sa Adijamus zúčastnil 6. ročníka celoštátej súťažnej prehliadky „Vánoční akordy“, kde získal cenné 2. miesto. V súčasnosti má zbor 38 členov z hudobných aj nehudobných odborov školy. Väčšina z nich nemá spevácke vzdelanie, ale sú výbornými inštrumentalistami či výtvarníkmi. Okrem hudby majú mnoho ďalších mimoškolských aktivít, napriek tomu si jeho členovia vždy nájdú čas na zborové nácviky, sústredenia a mnohé vystúpenia. Repertoár sa pomaly rozrástá. Obsahuje skladby z dôb renesancie až po súčasnosť. Svoje miesto v ňom majú ľudové piesne v rôznych úpravách, tradičné aj menej známe koledy, gospely a populárna hudba.

Mgr. Jana Adamusová vedie spevácky zbor Adijamus od jeho založenia v roku 2010. Je absolventkou Filozofickej fakulty Ostravskej univerzity, odbor český jazyk a hudobná výchova. Od roku 1996 pôsobí ako pedagogička na ZUŠ v Ostrave-Hrabůvce.



The Choir Adijamus was established six years ago at Vilém Petřelka Music School in Ostrava – Hrabůvka. Even though Adijamus choir is quite new, it has already taken part in several choral and singing competitions.

Probably the biggest success choir achieved was winning „Gold and Silver band“ in a regional choir competition of children choirs in Orlová. In December 2015 the choir took part in the 6th annual national competition „Vánoční akordy“ and was awarded a second place. Currently there are 38 singers in the choir – students of musical and non-musical departments of the music school. Most of them are not trained singers but great instrumentalists or painters. Even though they also have a lot of free time activities, they always find time to attend rehearsals and concerts. The repertoire is slowly growing and includes compositions dated from Renaissance to contemporary music. Folk songs in various styles, traditional and not very well known carols, gospel music and pop music are an important part of the repertoire.

Mgr. Jana Adamusová leads Adijamus choir from its very beginning in 2010. She graduated at the Faculty of Arts, University of Ostrava. She has been teaching at Vilém Petřelka's Music School in Ostrava – Hrabůvka since 1996.



Od roku 2002 je umeleckým vedúcim Zmiešaného speváckeho zboru KOS a Komorného zboru KOKOS Vyšszej odbornej školy pedagogickej a Strednej pedagogickej školy Litomyšl. Zbor KOS pod jeho vedením získal celý rad zlatých medailí na domácich i medzinárodných súťažiach a festivaloch. Milan Motl je členom celoštátnych organizácií pre zborový spev, aktívne pôsobí v hudobnej komisii Únie českých speváckych zborov a odbornej



rade NIPOS-ARTAMA Praha pre mládežnícky zborový spev. Venuje sa aktívnej speváckej činnosti, pôsobí tiež ako hlasový poradca.



Mixed choir KOS is a part of College and Secondary Teacher's Training School in Litomyšl. Its work is built on more than fifty years of choir tradition at the school. As every school choir it changes its members every year. The choir has been successfully presenting itself at festivals and choral competitions both at home and abroad where it traditionally occupies the best places. The choir has performed throughout Europe, 2008 in Canada, 2016 in USA. During the 15-year-existence of mixed singing, the choir has released seven CDs.

Milan Motl (\*1977) graduated from the Faculty of Education, University of Hradec Králové in the fields of music and history. Later, he also studied solo singing at the music department of the same university. He studied choir conducting at the university in Choir conducting lessons. Now he is attending private lessons in conducting and is a postgraduate student at Ostrava University in Ostrava. He gained his first choir experience by leading the preparatory department of the Bonifantes Boys Choir of Pardubice (1999 - 2003). Later he worked as their second concert choir choirmaster. Since 2002 he has been the artistic director of the KOS Mixed Choir and KOKOS Chamber Choir of the College and Secondary Teachers' Training School in Litomyšl. During his conducting the choir KOS gained a lot of gold medals in Czech as well as foreign contests and festivals. Milan Motl is a member of national organizations focusing on choir singing, he also participates in NIPOS-ARTAMA Expert Council Prague for youth choirs. He is an active singer and he works as a voice consultant.

Gaudete je miešaný chrámový spevácky zbor orientujúci sa najmä na sakrálnu hudbu. Hlavným poslaním zboru vždy bolo sprevádzať slávnostné sväté omše vo farskom kostole v Seredi (Slovenská republika), ale posledných 12 rokov vystupuje aj koncertne v domovskom meste a okolí. Okrem koncertov na Slovensku sa zboru podarilo koncertne vystúpiť aj v Holandsku, Rakúsku, Poľsku a Taliansku. Najväčším úspechom bolo sprevádzanie medzinárodnej svätej omše v Medžugorí, ktorá sa rozhlasom prenášala do celého sveta. Repertoár zboru tvoria sakrálné zborové skladby starších i novších autorov, afro-americké spirituály a gospely, či úpravy ľudových a populárnych piesní. V roku 2007 zbor nahral svoje prvé CD s názvom Spievajme Pánovi a v roku 2011 vydal druhé CD s názvom Jubilate Deo.

Andrea Ruczová sa prvýkrát stretla s prácou v speváckom zbere, keď sa ako študentka gymnázia stala korepetítorkou a neskôr asistentkou dirigenta v mestskom speváckom zbere Zvon. V r.1991 promovala na Pedagogickej fakulte v Nitre, kde bola aktívou členkou ženského speváckeho zberu Ponitran pod vedením Doc. Potočára, od ktorého získala vzácné skúsenosti. V roku 2013 sa stala dirigentkou miešaného chrámového speváckeho zberu Gaudete v Seredi, kde zároveň pôsobí ako organistka vo farskom kostole.



Gaudete is a mixed church choir which focuses mainly on sacred music. Since its existence its main purpose has always been accompanying holy masses in the parish church in the

city of Sered', but in recent 12 years they have also performed at concerts in their hometown and in the neighborhood. Besides the performances in Slovakia they also performed abroad, e.g. in the Netherlands, Austria, Poland and Italy. Their biggest success was singing at the international holy mass in Medzúgorje, which was broadcasted on the radio to the whole world. The repertoire of the choir includes sacred compositions of old and contemporary composers, Afro-American spirituals and gospels but also folk and popular songs arranged for choirs. In 2007 the choir released its first album Spievajme Pánovi (Sing to the Lord) and in 2011 its second one Jubilate Deo.

Mrs. Andrea Ruczová first met with the choral work as a student of a secondary school when she started accompanying the Mixed choir Zvon in her hometown. Later she became conductor's assistant, too. In 1991 she graduated from the Pedagogical faculty of Nitra University where she was an active member of the female choir Ponitran conducted by Doc. Potočar from whom she got a lot of experience and knowledge. In 2003 she became the conductor of the mixed church choir in Sered' where she is also the organist in the local church.

**MIXED CHOIR APOLLO /SLOVAKIA/**

Non-competing choir

Spevácky zbor Apollo vznikol v roku 1995 ako vysokoškolský zbor, v ktorom spievajú študenti a absolventi z celého Slovenska študujúci a pracujúci v Bratislave. Za veľmi krátky čas sa zbor vypracoval na kvalitný reprezentatívny zbor Slovenska o čom svedčí rad súťažných ocenení. Z posledných úspechov hodno spomenúť prvé miesto v štyroch kategóriách, špeciálnu cenu za interpretáciu renesančnej skladby a špeciálnu cenu pre najlepšieho dirigenta na medzinárodnom festivale "Singing World" v ruskom Petrohrade. Spevácky zbor Apollo zameriava svoj repertoár na súčasnú sakrálnu slovenskú tvorbu. Naštudoval a interpretoval rozsiahle skladby od vynikajúceho slovenského skladateľa Pavla Kršku. Súčasťou repertoáru zboru je aj sakrálna zborová tvorba z obdobia gregoriánskeho chorálu, renesancie, romantizmu a súčasnosti, rovnako ako ľudové piesne a koledy v zborovej úprave. Zbor každoročne usporadúva benefičné koncerty v prospech Detskej onkologickej kliníky v Bratislave. Je spoluorganizátorom festivalov zborovej hudby v Bratislave.

Milan Kolena je umeleckým riaditeľom medzinárodných zborových a orchestrálnych festivalov Bratislavu, vyučuje zborové dirigovanie a gregoriánsky chorál na Vysokej škole Muzických umení v Bratislave a je predsedom Únie speváckych zborov Slovenska. So speváckym zborom Apollo a Scholou gregoriana Bratislavensis sa zúčastnil mnohých prestížnych súťaží v celej Európe. V rokoch 2004 – 2006 nahral spolu so Scholou Gregoriana Bratislavensis 3 CD Bratislavských antifón pre Slovenskú národnú knižnicu. V roku 2014 úspešne prednášal na troch amerických univerzitách - Illinois Wesleyan University School of Music, University of Missouri School of Music, Colorado State University na tému: Interpretácia latinského textu v sakrálnej zborovej tvorbe. Na festivale "Singing World" v ruskom Petrohrade bol v roku 2015 ocenený ako najlepší dirigent festivalu a tom istom roku viedol niekoľko workshopov v Číne a v Hong Kongu.



Choir Apollo was established in 1995 and in a short time the choir made considerable strides, achieving notoriety in Slovakia and receiving many awards at festivals and international competitions. The choir often gives performances at prestigious local and international events. The choir's repertoire focuses on current sacred Slovak works; the choir interprets extensive pieces by outstanding Slovak composer Pavol Krška, and its repertoire also includes sacred choruses from the Gregorian Chant period, as well as Renaissance and Romantic period selections; spirituals, folksongs and carols in choir arrangements.

Choir. In 2015 the choir won four 1st prizes and two special prizes (for performance of Renaissance music and the best conductor) at the international competition "Singing World" in St. Petersburg, Russia.

Milan Kolena is a conductor, artistic director of Bratislava Music Festivals, teacher of choral conducting and Gregorian Chant at the Academy of Performing Arts in Bratislava and the president of Slovak Choral Association. With his choir Apollo and Schola Gregoriana Bratislavensis Milan Kolena visited many prestigious choral competitions. In 2014 he gave lectures at three American universities: Illinois Wesleyan University School, University of Missouri School of Music, Colorado State University, topic: The Question of the Interpretation of Latin texts in Sacred Choral Music. He frequently works as a member of the jury at many international choral and orchestral competitions in Slovakia, Europe and Asia. He was awarded the best conductor special prize of the „Singing World“ choral competition in St. Petersburg, Russia in 2015. In the same year he held choral workshops in China and Hong Kong.

Bratislava is a beautiful city full of culture that is gradually being discovered by visitors from all over the world. ## St. Martin's Cathedral

This Gothic cathedral constructed in the 14th century served as coronation place of Hungarian kings from 1563 to 1830. The cathedral's important

## Primate Palace

The monumental Renaissance palace rebuilt in Classicist style used to be the seat of Cardinal Jozef Batthyányi. The palace's function is symbolized by a black cardinal's hat that can be seen on the top of the roof. In the past, the palace witnessed many crucial moments in the country's history, e.g. signing of the „Peace of Bratislava“ after Napoleon's victory at the Battle of Austerlitz. Today it houses a precious collection of paintings and tapestries with ancient Greek motives that were discovered by chance during the palace's reconstruction.



## Jesuit church

The church was built in 1638 in neo-renaissance style and is one of the biggest Bratislava churches. Its simple exterior decoration contrasts to the beautifully ornated interior. The two side naves are adorned with beautiful baroque altars from the 18th century. The main altar with monumental pillars comes from the 19th century. One of the church's highlights is a unique rococo pulpit from 1753 made of unusual combination of wood, lead and gold. The church has a very good acoustics and is often a venue of classic and sacred music concerts.

## Main square

The history of the square dates back to the early Medieval period when there used to be a market and the place of citizens' meetings and trials. The Old Town Hall with Gothic interiors and baroque steeple today houses the city museum and often hosts concerts of classic, jazz or folk music in the courtyard. The square's main highlight is the fountain with the statue of the famous knight Roland who, as the legends say, used to dwell in Bratislava for a long time.


